The annual Business Meeting of the Association of Mathematics Teacher Educators of Alabama was held on November 1, 2013 during the Alabama Council of Teachers of Mathematics Fall Forum at Alabama State University. The meeting was called to order by Tommy Smith, President.

The minutes from the November 2012 meeting were read. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes. The motion passed.

Topics discussed included the following:

- ★ What should be the next step in implementing an Elementary Math Specialist program? Discussions included possible structures/delivery methods, the reading specialist program as a model, jointly offered courses among institutions, and working closely with stake holders in the schools. Consensus was that the program would most likely be developed as a masters' level program. It was decided that a smaller group should work on this and bring forward a proposal. Megan Burton, Stefanie Livers, Marilyn Strutchens, Ann Dominick, and Sherry Parrish agreed to serve on this group.
- ★ There was a discussion about increasing dues. A motion was made and seconded to increase dues to \$10 effective July 1 with the beginning of the new fiscal year. The motion passed.
- ★ The AlaMATYC Conference will be February 28 at Lawson State. Tommy Smith will contact them about a proposal to have an interest meeting regarding elementary teacher education programs.
